



Dr. Darrin Oehlerking is Professor of Music and Interim Associate Dean of Student Affairs in the College of Arts and Science at the University of Saskatchewan. He previously served as Director of Bands and Jazz at Bemidji State University in Bemidji, Minnesota, and as Music Coordinator for the Louis Riel School Division in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Dr. Oehlerking earned his Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA) in Wind Conducting at The University of Iowa, where he studied with Dr. Myron Welch. He earned his Masters in Music Performance with an emphasis in Conducting, as well as separate Bachelors degrees in Music and Education from the University of Manitoba.

Dr. Oehlerking is currently the Chair of the Collegiate Wind Conductors of Canada. He is also a member of several other professional organizations, including the College Band Directors National Association, Saskatchewan Band Association, WASBE, and Pi Kappa Lambda. He is a Yamaha artist/educator, and has served as an adjudicator, guest conductor, clinician, and conference presenter in Canada, the United States, England, and Germany. In 2021, he was the Director of the virtual National Youth Band of Canada, and in 2022 he led the return of the in-person version of this ensemble in Toronto, Ontario.
