2024 ADJUDICATORS



Holly De Caigny Woodwind

Holly De Caigny is a contemporary saxophonist who strives to collaborate with a variety of artists. She has performed publicly across Canada, the United States, as well as in Slovenia, France, and Thailand. Most recently, she has toured Eastern Canada with Proteus Quartet, performed online and in person with Timepoint Ensemble, performed in free improvisation concerts with Secret Lady Project and Bug Incision, and has collaborated with composers including Colin Labadie, Vincent Ho, Jordan Nobles, and Laurie Radford. Holly maintains a busy studio at Mount Royal Conservatory and serves as Director of Music in the King's Own Calgary Regiment Band.

Having just completed her Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of Alberta, Holly is excited to continue to grow her studio of enthusiastic saxophone students of all ages and levels, as well as working with two high school saxophone ensembles, clinics for various schools, and working with saxophone students at Mount Royal Conservatory. Aside from teaching, Holly works as the

Director of Operations, saxophonist, and Board member for Timepoint Ensemble, a member of Proteus Quartet, and a member of the King's Own Calgary Regiment Band.

Holly earned a Doctor of Music degree with Dr. William Street at the University of Alberta, a Master's degree from the University of Calgary, a Bachelor's degree from the University of British Columbia, and two artist diplomas from the Conservatoire à Rayonnement Régional de Boulogne-Billancourt, France.



Bill Dimmer Band **Bill Dimmer** has been described as a "cornerstone" of Edmonton's music scene. The structural metaphor explains his selection as an Artist/Builder in Edmonton's Arts and Culture Hall of Fame 2014. Between his arrival in 1971 and his retirement from the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra in 2014, Bill served as a teacher, mentor, administrator, conductor, and performer, including a potential Canadian record 43 seasons as ESO assistant principal trumpet. Bill played a seminal role in creating the ESO's educational concert series, which he was involved in for over 20 years and introduced a generation of Edmontonians to the orchestra. The ESO has been at the forefront of educational programming in North America and much of the credit is due to Bill's talent for engaging young people – he's been known to don eye-popping theme costumes, from green cats to aliens, to win their attention. Bill has shared his musical knowledge with countless private students, teaching at

post-secondary institutions such as the University of Alberta and Grant MacEwan University, acting as clinician and adjudicator at workshops and festivals in Western Canada, and, with students at the MusiCamrose summer music camp, where he served as managing director for several years. He has performed with several groups including the Tommy Banks Band and the Plumbers Union, and is currently music director of the Nova Musica Concert Orchestra and is active as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator. A skilled pilot, he is an active air crew member and instructor with the Civil Air Search and Rescue Association and ground school instructor at the Edmonton Flying Club. He has been known to fly colleagues to remote northern communities as part of the National Arts Centre's music outreach clinics.



Katherine Dowling Junior Piano Plan I (10-12 Years) Praised by *The New York Times* for her "crystalline performances, gestural expressiveness, and careful attention to color" and by *The Boston Globe* for her "effortless incisiveness", award-winning "tour-de-force" (OpusKlassiek, Berkshire Eagle) pianist **Katherine Dowling** performs across North America and Europe as a soloist and chamber musician.

Katherine is familiar to audiences as an artist-in-residence at the Orlando Festival (Netherlands) and a resident fellow of the Avaloch Farm Music Institute (USA); as a multi-year fellow of the Tanglewood Music Center, a New Fromm Fellow, a Britten-Pears Young Artist, an International Musicians' Seminar at Prussia Cove artist; through extensive involvement and numerous positions at The Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity; and through multiple national tours under the auspices of the Eckhardt-Gramatté National Music Competition. She treasures her many collaborative

relationships, most especially recital partner Catherine Cosbey (Cavani String Quartet), with whom she is co-director of the Regina Chamber Music Festival. As a soloist, and as a member of the chamber ensemble Gruppo Montebello, Katherine appears on eight critically-acclaimed recordings on the Etcetera label. Her performances have been broadcast on the CBC (Canada), Radio-Canada, BBC (United Kingdom), and National Radio 4 (Netherlands). Recent highlights include joining Angela Hewitt and Silvie Cheng in W.A. Mozart's *Triple Concerto* at Ottawa Chamberfest; her Vienna recital début; several tours with violinist Kerry DuWors for Prairie Debut; a recording of the piano works of Alice Ping-Yee Ho (Canada Council for the Arts, Explore and Create); and appearing with the Regina Symphony Orchestra in Florence Price's *Piano Concerto*.

In addition to her performing activities, Katherine is Assistant Professor of Classical Piano Performance at York University, having formerly served as Assistant Professor of Piano Performance at the University of Regina. She is also on faculty at The Phil and Eli Taylor Academy for Young Artists (Royal Conservatory of Music); duo526 Sonata Seminar (Indiana University Jacobs School of Music); and the European Summer Course for Chamber Music (Netherlands). She has served on the jury for the National Finals of the Canadian Music Competition, enjoys adjudicating at both the regional and provincial levels, and teaches master classes and workshops across Canada every season. She credits her own teacher, celebrated American pianist Gilbert Kalish, and conductors Henk Guittart and Oliver Knussen, as the major influences in her musical life. She holds a Doctor of Musical Arts (Performance) degree from Stony Brook University (New York).



Michel Fournier Intermediate Piano Plan I Senior Piano Plan I Doctor of Music, pedagogue, soloist, and collaborative pianist, **Michel Fournier** has captivated the most demanding audiences with his unique sound palette, inherited from great masters such as Yvonne Hubert, Yvonne Lefébure, Menahem Pressler, and Marc Durand.

As a soloist and with orchestra, Michel Fournier has performed extensively across Canada, the USA, and Europe, and has collaborated with world-class musicians. A considerable number of his performances have been broadcast on Radio-Canada and CBC. He has many albums and movie soundtracks to his credit. His interpretations of Debussy's *Preludes* have won the most rave reviews:

"...perfect knowledge of the expressive resources of the piano, a **tour de force** that ranks him among the masters of impressionist music." (Adveratul de Cluj – Romania).

Highly appreciated as an educator, Michel Fournier has provided guidance to thousands of musicians, teaching master classes, coaching, and adjudicating national competitions for young musicians across North America, Europe, and Asia. Many of his students have won national and international *competitions (American Protégé, Tureck International Bach Competition, Thousand Islands International Chopin Competition, Canadian Music Competition, International Stepping Stone, National Music Festival*).

His passion for passing on his knowledge has led him to devote several months a year to evaluating and advising young musicians, both in Canada and abroad: he has participated in numerous jury panels including the Canadian Music Competition, the Canadian Federation of Music Festivals, the Hong Kong School Music Festival, and many others. He is regularly invited to give master classes and lectures at various institutions in Canada. In 2023, he was chosen as one of the two National Judges for the 3-month Canadian tour of the Canadian Music Competition, where he listened, assessed, and commented on more than 600 performances offered by several of Canada's most talented young musicians, spanning 12 cities between Halifax and Vancouver.

Michel Fournier is co-owner and artistic director of *St-André Management*, a performing arts agency which represents both established and young emerging artists.

Michel Fournier was associate professor at Université de Sherbrooke.



David Gillham Upper Strings

Canadian Violinist **David Gillham** regularly appears as chamber musician, in recital and as soloist in major cities and venues across four continents. A sought after teacher, Mr. Gillham is an Associate Professor of Violin at the University of British Columbia School of Music and is the director of the Violin Programme at the Domaine Forget International Music Festival and Academy. Mr. Gillham has given master classes throughout North and South America, China, Taiwan, and South Africa.

Mr. Gillham was, for many years, a member of the acclaimed Arianna String Quartet (USA) and is a founding member of the Ridge Piano Trio and the violin and piano duo "Gillham-Iinuma".

In 2002, Mr. Gillham received the Queen Elizabeth II Golden Jubilee Medal in honour of his contributions to the arts in Canada.



Wendy Grasdahl Brass

Wendy Grasdahl is a conductor, trumpet performer, educator, and adjudicator. Her professional work encompasses teaching at university and college levels across Canada, military band work, and private instruction.

As an officer in the Canadian Naval Reserve, Wendy has conducted military bands in Alberta, B.C., Ontario, and Nova Scotia. She is in demand as a clinician and guest conductor for school programs, as well as summer music programs, including 12 years at the International Music Camp at the Peace Garden on the Manitoba/U.S. border where she received the Distinguished Service Award for conducting and promoting band in North America. Other awards include: The Faculty Association Excellence in Teaching Award, University of P.E.I.; 2014 City of Edmonton Salute to Excellence Citation Award in Arts & Culture. In 2019, the Alberta Band Association awarded her the

"Vondis Miller Legacy" Award.

Having appeared as a trumpet soloist and in professional ensembles across Canada, Wendy is a founding member of the brass quintet "Five of a Kind", and has played Solo Cornet with the Mill Creek Colliery Brass Band. She is the founder, Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of Festival City Winds Music Society which in 2020 celebrated its 25th season.

Wendy currently teaches Instrumental Conducting and Brass Techniques at The King's University, Edmonton.

She has adjudicated festivals at local, regional, and national levels in 8 provinces to date.

Ms. Grasdahl holds a B.Mus. in Music History from the University of Alberta, an M.Mus. in Trumpet Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Calgary, and a graduate level Fine Arts Diploma in Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble Conducting and Literature from the University of Calgary.



Arlene Irwin Junior Speech Arts Senior Speech Arts

Arlene Irwin brings more than 30 years of stage experience to her role as Speech Arts & Drama Instructor on the faculty at Mount Royal University Conservatory. A native of Northern Ireland, she has been studying Speech Arts and Drama since the age of 14.

Throughout the years, not only has she won numerous speech and drama awards, but also continues to be an active theatre performer. Arlene's most recent roles were as 'Mother Superior' in Storybook Theatre's musical production of *Sister Act* and in 2022, the role of 'Irene Ruddock' in Alan Bennett's *A Lady of Letters* for which she received the award of outstanding performer at the Calgary One-Act Play Festival.

Holding an Associate & Licentiate diploma in Speech Arts and Drama from Trinity College London and an ARCT Teachers accreditation from RCM, Arlene also operates a private drama school and has adjudicated at numerous Speech Arts Festivals including The Kelowna Kiwanis Music Festival, Brooks, and Lethbridge Music Festivals.

She has also had the pleasure of working with Autism Calgary and the Autism/Asperger's Friendship Society teaching drama and social skills to a variety of enthusiastic students on the Autism spectrum.

Arlene is thrilled to have the opportunity to adjudicate at the Edmonton Music & Speech Arts Festival and extremely excited to hear the work of all the talented students.



Beverly Ivany Junior Piano Plan II

Beverly Ivany began piano lessons at the age of four, and has never looked back. She studied with several teachers including Edward Parker (Vancouver); then Thelma O'Neill (Edmonton)-receiving her A.R.C.T in piano performance in her late teens. Soon after, she began teaching piano at Alberta College. Following a Bachelor of Arts degree, Beverly went on to receive her Bachelor of Music degree, studying piano with Helmut Brauss at The University of Alberta.

Beverly has never stopped teaching to students of all ages throughout her career. Besides teaching piano, Beverly has adjudicated at various music festivals and competitions in Saskatchewan, Ontario, and Québec. She has accompanied dance schools, such as the one which was held annually in Olds, Alberta for many years—supported by the Alberta Department of Education; also the Vermillion Dance School summer program. Beverly has accompanied various choirs, ntermediate Piano Plan II including the U of A Concert Choir under the direction of Dr. David Stocker. She also has accompanied numerous students for their vocal exams and competitions-from various studios such

as Sherrill DeMarco.

Beverly has directed many musicals in various cities across Canada. She presently conducts a community choir in Toronto, and sings in a semi-professional choir—The Canadian Staff Songsters—that has travelled extensively across Canada and the United States.

Although she sings and plays a brass instrument, the piano is her first love. Beverly is thrilled to be returning to Edmonton-to witness the development of so many wonderful young musicians in this great city!

Bachelor of Music from the University of Southern California. She has an Associate Teacher's Diploma from Mount Royal University and an ARCT Teacher's Diploma from the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto (RCM). Her major teachers were: Willard Schultz, Charles Foreman, Priscilla King, Peter Turner, James Bonn, Adam Wibrowski, Donald Bell, Dr. Marienne Uszler, and Dr. Jean Barr. Ms. Kundert is a successful independent studio teacher, RCM senior examiner, Frederick Harris editor & reviewer, festival adjudicator, collaborative artist, and she is a master class and workshop clinician. She is the Co-Founder and Creative Director of Cassa Musical Arts, which celebrated its 30th Anniversary in 2023.

Linda Kundert holds a Master of Music in Piano Performance from the University of Calgary and a

Ms. Kundert was honoured with the Alberta Registered Music Teachers' Association (ARMTA) Recognition Award in 2006, was Chair of the Canadian Federation of Music Teachers' Association (CFMTA) "Peak Performance" Conference and Celebration held in Calgary in 2005, and in 2011, was

presented with the CFMTA Hugheen Ferguson Distinguished Teacher Award. Ms. Kundert was also honoured with the City of Calgary 2015 Community Achievement in the Arts Award, and was awarded Teacher of Distinction by the RCM in 2016. She is currently a piano instructor at Mount Royal University and teaches from her home studio in Okotoks, inperson and online. Her students continue to receive many awards and scholarships in both performance and composition. Ms. Kundert loves to teach; she has nurtured many students of all ages and levels. With her guidance, more than 50 students have achieved their ARCT and Licentiate diplomas. For fun, she enjoys riding her horses, Leo and Caity, and she plays competitive softball.



Jennifer Lang Choir **Dr. Jennifer Lang** is an Associate Professor of Music Education and the Director of Choral Activities at the University of Saskatchewan. She is a co-lead for the University of Saskatchewan's newly recognized Signature Area in Health & Wellness and serves as the Pillar Lead for Music, Arts, and Wellbeing. She is the Graduate Chair and organizer of the Department of Music's Music Education in Action Series, the founder and organizer of the uSing uSask Choral Festival, the conductor of the Greystone Singers and the Founder and Artistic Director of Aurora Voce. Her choirs regularly perform with the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra and other celebrated ensembles and composers. Dr. Lang has adjudicated most recently at the Saskatchewan Music Festival in Saskatoon and Regina in 2023; the Manitoba ChoralFest in 2022; Cantando Festival 2019 in Alberta; ChorFest 2019 in Saskatchewan; the Moose Jaw Band and Choral Festival 2019; ChoralFest North 2018 in Alberta; 2017

Cantando Sun Peaks Festival in British Columbia; and ChorFest 2016 in Saskatchewan.

Jennifer's research examines engagement and agency in music education programs, including informal music learning in a variety of educational contexts, intergenerational singing programs, and language and music development for Newcomer Youth to Canada for which she holds several research grants. Jennifer is also active as a conductor, choral adjudicator, clinician and conference presenter. Her forthcoming edited book, *Music and wellbeing in education and community contexts*, presents a variety of contributed chapters exploring the intersections of music education and wellbeing. Jennifer is active as a conductor, clinician, and conference presenter with local, provincial, national, and international invitations. Before moving to the province of Saskatchewan, Jennifer taught high school music in Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario.



Winston Noren has been active as a teacher of voice for over 40 years. In 1992, he joined the voice faculty at the distinguished Mount Royal University Conservatory where he currently has a studio of 25 students. Many of his former students have gone on to have highly successful careers, most notably on Broadway and in opera houses throughout North America and Europe. Mr. Noren has also given numerous master classes and workshops, and is well known across Canada as an adjudicator for provincial and regional festivals. From 2000 to 2020, Mr. Noren was a member of the College of Examiners for the Royal Conservatory of Music.

For several years, Mr. Noren was active as a choral conductor. In addition to conducting a highly successful women's choir from 1984 to 1990, he has also been a conductor for the Alberta Summer Music Workshop, the Mount Royal Children's Choir, the Calgary Gilbert and Sullivan Society, and

the Alberta Centennial Choir. From 1998 to 2005, he was Director of Music at the Cathedral Church of the Redeemer in Calgary.

As a soloist, Mr. Noren, a baritone, performed frequently in recital and as a guest artist. He is a past president of the Southern Alberta Chapter of the National Association of Singing and a former instructor in the Mount Royal Vocal Academy, a program for teens designed to enhance their private lessons through participation in staged scenes, monthly recitals, master classes, and musicianship classes.



Yvette Rowledge Senior Piano Plan II

Yvette Rowledge graduated with distinction from the University of Victoria School of Music and holds diplomas from the Royal Conservatory of Music (ARCT, Performance) and the Victoria Conservatory of Music (AVCM, Performance and Pedagogy).

She is a former faculty member of the Langley Community Music School, the Victoria Conservatory and the Douglas College Community Music School. Her tutors have included Dr. Robin Wood, Winifred Scott Wood, Dr. Gordana Lazarevich, and Bruce Vogt.

Samantha Spurrier earned her Bachelor of Music in harp performance from the University of Alberta and is currently a sought-after solo and ensemble player across Alberta. She currently serves as the principal harpist of the Regina Symphony Orchestra. Jennie Such enjoys a career as a performer, adjudicator, and instructor. She holds an Honours Bachelor of Music degree in Vocal Performance from the University of Western Ontario and three ARCM Post Graduate Diplomas specializing in Concert and Opera Studies, from the Royal College of Music in London, England.

As an emerging artist, Jennie worked as a young company member with the Vancouver Opera Touring Ensemble, and the Canadian Opera Company Ensemble.

Jennie's diverse career spans the genres of oratorio, opera, recital, and musical theatre. She has sung principal roles with Broomhill Opera (U.K), Calgary Opera, Edmonton Opera, Opera Atelier, Pacific Opera Victoria, Opera Ontario, Vancouver Opera, Mirvish Productions, and the Canadian Opera Company.

As an oratorio soloist, Jennie has performed throughout Canada as well as in Germany and the U.K. On the concert stage, Jennie made her soloist début with the Vancouver Symphony and the Vancouver Chamber Choir in Brahms' *Ein Deutches Requiem* for which *The Globe and Mail* wrote: *"Such sang 'Ihr habt nun Traurigkeit' with melting beauty of tone, her silvery instrument powerfully and movingly conveying the aria's warmth and sublime tenderness."*

Her live performances in opera, concert, and recital have been broadcast on CBC Radio, MDR (Germany), and the BBC (U.K). She has also recorded works for CBC Records and the Naxos label.

As a singing coach, Jennie's first engagement was as the resident vocal coach for the Toronto Mirvish production of *Billy Elliot* in 2011, where she worked extensively with professional youth and adult actors in principal roles. She has also coached young actors in the National Arts Centre production of *The Hockey Sweater*. In the 2023 season, Jennie was a vocal coach at Opera NUOVA in Edmonton where she worked with the opera and musical theatre performers. Over the past decade, her teaching and vocal coaching résumé has expanded, and is now the cornerstone of her musical work.

This season, Jennie will direct Opera Laurier's 2023/24 productions. She looks forward to approaching singing and teaching from this new perspective.

Jennie is a Voice Instructor at Wilfrid Laurier University, and the Singing Coach at The Birmingham Conservatory (Stratford Festival Young Artists Training Programme), and at the Stratford Festival, where 2023 marks her 10th season with the company.

In this unique role, she works with classical actors and musical theatre performers, helping them learn and maintain the music which they will perform in the musicals and plays throughout the season. She also collaborates with the musical director and the rest of the coaching team to help maintain the vocal health of the musical and acting companies.

As an adjudicator, Jennie has served for the Ontario Arts Council as well as the Kiwanis and Rotary Festival Organizations in both regional and provincial competitions.

Awards include grants from the Ontario Arts Council, the Canada Council for the Arts, and the USC Teaching Excellence "Honour Roll" Award (Western University) as well as a Tyrone Guthrie Award from the Stratford Festival.



Murray Visscher has performed a wide variety of music for audiences in Canada and the United States. Although his formal education is primarily in Classical music, his diverse background has put him on stage with some of Canada's elite jazz, folk, rock, and fiddle artists. Murray's recent efforts include many premières of new music written for the Oberon Guitar Trio (along with colleagues Ralph Maier and Brad Mahon).

Murray is in demand as an instructor and educator, and currently serves on the faculties of Mount Royal University Conservatory and Ambrose University in Calgary, Canada. He adjudicates frequently at festivals and competitions throughout Western Canada, and has served on the editing team for the Royal Conservatory of Music's guitar series.

From the National Arts Centre to the Venice Biennale, she performs widely as soloist and in ensembles including the Australian Art Orchestra, Houston Symphony Orchestra, Manitoba Chamber Orchestra, and ORFIX in Mexico. She collaborates, records, and tours extensively with songwriters and composers including John. K Samson, the Mountain Goats, Eric Platz, Robert Honstein, Travis Weller, the Hylozoists, Nicole Lizée's SaskPower, and her long-time collaborator, Christine Fellows. She recently premièred Nicole Lizée's new *Cello Concerto* and a new work for cello and choir by Cree composer Andrew Balfour.

On faculty at Brandon University, Leanne co-directs Wheat City Nuit Blanche, the Wild Studio workshop (held in Canadian National Parks) and has taught at the Rosamunde Academy, Cadenza Music Week, Prairie Cello Institute, Domaine Forget International Festival, Hybrid Intensive (San Francisco), and lectured at the Parsons School of Design in New York, the Winnipeg Art Gallery, and Banff Research in Culture Workshop. Her solo album *Music for Spaces* was released on Redshift Records in 2021. She holds degrees from the University of Manitoba, Shepherd School of Music at Rice University, and a doctorate from the University of Texas – Austin.



Ranald Shean 1914-1997

Vera Shean 1923-2005

The Shean Strings & Piano Competition, made possible by a generous grant to the Edmonton Community Foundation from Ranald and Vera Shean in 1996, is open to amateur musicians between 15 and 28 years of age who are residents of Canada currently studying here or abroad, or to non-residents who have been studying in Canada for a minimum of two academic years. Six semi-finalists are chosen from the submitted discs. The winner of the 2024 Competition will be invited to perform with the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra at a later date. Strings and piano are

featured in alternative years. Ranald Shean excelled in both music and sports and was a "Master Teacher". Vera Shean was an equally gifted violinist and pianist. They met in Vancouver where Ranald was Gregori Garbovitsky's associate teacher and Vera was Garbovitsky's student. Vera also continued advanced piano studies with Sir Arthur Benjamin. They married and began a lifelong collaboration in music, predominantly in the Edmonton area.

In the 1940s, Ranald was concertmaster and conductor of the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra. In addition to playing violin in the Symphony, Vera performed in recital and as an accompanist on the CBC. Ranald also conducted the Edmonton Youth Orchestra. In 1966, they established the Edmonton Conservatory of Music that later merged with the Alberta College Conservatory of Music.

Their passion was teaching. During their lives, they both maintained a full teaching schedule (Vera - piano, Ranald – violin) working seven days a week. Sunday was "Open House" for their students. Any student who wanted to come and practice, work with an accompanist (Vera), get extra coaching, play in an ensemble, etc. was welcome. Both Ranald and Vera were elected to the City of Edmonton's Arts & Culture Hall of Fame.

Their dream for young musicians to experience the same passion they had lives on in The Shean Competition.

Henry From - Bellingham, WA

Henry From is a planist and composer who is currently studying with John O'Conor at The Glenn Gould School in Toronto, where he is the recipient of the Ihnatowycz Prize in Plano. He previously studied with

Amanda Chan and Edward Top at the Vancouver Academy of Music. Mr. From was named by the CBC to be among its Top 30 Musicians Under 30 in 2019. Other honours include a first prize in the 2018 Montréal Symphony Orchestra Manulife Competition, the Tabor Award at the Verbier Festival in 2021, Grand Prize and Public Choice Award at the Orford Music Award in 2022, and a Davidson Fellow Scholarship in 2022. As a composer, he has received top prizes from the SOCAN Young Composer Awards, BMI Student Composer Competition, and the Canadian Music Centre's Prairie

Region Composer Competition. Mr. From is an Associate Composer of the Canadian Music Centre. Recent performance highlights include soloist appearances with the Seattle Symphony and the Royal Conservatory Orchestra, recitals at the Verbier Festival in Switzerland, the Seattle Chamber Music Society, the Rockport Chamber Music Festival, and numerous Morningside Music Bridge recitals in Boston, Poland, and Israel. Mr. From has had premières of his orchestral compositions by the Vancouver and Winnipeg symphony orchestras.



Carter Johnson – Campbell River, BC

Praised for his interpretive sensitivity, imaginative programming, and ability to make classical music speak to all kinds of audiences, Canadian pianist Carter Johnson is quickly establishing a reputation as one of his generation's most gifted and multi-faceted pianists. He has won first prize in international competitions including the 2023 Concours « Les Étoiles du Piano », the 2023 Weatherford College International Piano Competition, the 2021 International Competition of Polish Music, and the 2020 Valsesia International Competition. He was also recently awarded the Most Promising Pianist not Proceeding to the Final in the 2023 Sydney International Piano Competition, where he also garnered the award for the Best Program Presentation in the Semi-final for his program design and verba introductions. He has also won first prize in important Canadian competitions such as the 2018 OSM Competition and the 2018 CMC Stepping Stone.

Mr. Johnson has given solo and concerto performances in over a dozen countries, and has collaborated with orchestras such as the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra, l'Orchestre Symphonique de Montréal, and the Orchestra of the Americas

Born in Campbell River, British Columbia, Mr. Johnson holds a BMus from the University of British Columbia, an MM from the Juilliard School, and an MMA from the Yale School of Music, where he is now currently a doctoral candidate, studying under Wei-Yi Yang. He currently resides in Hamden, Connecticut with his wife Hannah and their two young boys.

Dane Ko – Mississauga, ON Prize winner in the 2023 Concour Prix Ravel in Fontainebleau, Hong Kong-born Canadian pianist Dane Ko is active as recitalist, chamber musician, and educator on international stages. Among his growing accolades, Mr. Ko was recognized in the 2022 Glenn Gould School Chamber Music Competition, the 2019 "Stepping Stone" of the Canadian Music Competition, and the 2021 Ricard Viñes International Piano Competition in Spain. Mr. Ko regularly takes part in prestigious festivals which include ISA International Summer Academy of the mdw, MusicAlp. Rebecca Penneys Piano Festival, and Fontainebleau during which he was awarded second prize in Fondation Maurice Ravel's Prix Ravel and the Prix Langage Musique.

Mr. Ko holds a Bachelor and Master of Music from the University of Toronto and an Artist Diploma from The Glenn Gould School of The Royal Conservatory of Music supported by full scholarships. Mr. Ko is

currently pursuing the Doctor of Music degree at McGill University Schulich School of Music as a recipient of the Max Stern Fellowship. Mr. Ko is indebted to his teachers which include Marietta Orlov, Lydia Wong, and Ilya Poletaev, as well as master class studies with Robert Levin, Klaus Hellwig, Ronan O'Hora, John Perry, Benedetto Lupo, Eric Le Sage, and others.

Gabriel Landstedt – Los Lunas, NM



Gabriel Landstedt has performed at festivals and competitions throughout North America and Europe. Recent competition prizes include Grand Prize at the Architecture of Music Competition, Grand Prize in the Royal Sound Music Competition, and first runner-up in the UBC Concerto Competition. When Mr. Landstedt was 16, he won First Prize in the Jackie McGehee Young Artists' Competition, after which he made his orchestra début with the New Mexico Philharmonic. Festival appearances include the Chautauqua Piano Program, Art of the Piano, Eastern Music Festival, New Mexico Chamber Music Festival, Klavierfestival Lindlar in Germany, Salzburg International Summer Academy in Austria, and Val Tidone and Brindisi Piano Camps in Italy. Mr. Landstedt has performed solo and collaborative recitals throughout North America. In 2016, Mr.

Landstedt recorded Shostakovich's *Piano Concerto No.* 1 with the Albuquerque-based Duke Symphonette. He made his New York début the next year. In 2021, he established the vocal-piano ensemble Keyprano Duo with soprano Allison Anderson.

Mr. Landstedt graduated summa cum laude with his Bachelor of Music degree and Second Major in German from the University of New Mexico. He has made additional studies at the Hochschule für Musik Würzburg in Germany and Manhattan School of Music. In 2020, he graduated with his Master of Music degree at the University of British Columbia, where he was as a student of Mark Anderson. Mr. Landstedt is now pursuing his DMA degree at UBC as a recipient of the university's premier Four Year Doctoral Fellowship.

Jingzi (Linda) Ruan – Surrey, BC



Chinese-Canadian pianist Linda Ruan is passionate about sharing the potential of music to overcome boundaries across cultures. Since being introduced to the drums at the age of four and then the piano at age seven, music has remained a stabilizing force in her childhood from Tokyo, Shanghai, and to Vancouver. Her unconventional path from a young age broadened her horizons and cultivated a fascination for diverse cultures. Her curiosity guided her beyond her solo piano studies, expanding to pedagogy and community engagement, fortepiano, conducting, and chamber music projects. Ms. Ruan is a top prize winner in international piano competitions including the ARD International Music Competition 2021. She has performed in venues across the world, from Carnegie's Weill Hall and Lincoln Center's Rose Studio to a recital tour in China spanning Guangzhou to Shanghai.

Ms. Ruan received her Bachelor of Music with Honours and Master of Music degrees from The Glenn Gould School, The Juilliard School, and the Tianjin Juilliard School, respectively. Her past teachers include James Anagnoson Hung-Kuan Chen, Corey Hamm, Xiao Li, Li Wang, and Xiaohan Wang. Currently, she is studying at the UBC School of Music with Dr. Corey Hamm.

Adam Sun – Burnaby, BC

GUIDANCE <u>RE:</u> RECORDING OF PERFORMANCES & ADJUDICATIONS KEEPING YOUNG PERFORMERS SAFE

The Edmonton Music & Speech Arts Festival Committee recognizes that participation in music festivals can help children grow in confidence, increase their self-esteem and provide a basis on which to learn a range of new skills, as well as give some the chance to build a career in the creative sector. We want to make sure that children can take advantage of these opportunities wherever possible so that they can make the most of these benefits and enjoy the opportunity to perform in public.

Guidance provides a framework to ensure that the welfare of performing children is safeguarded effectively, that they receive proper care, and that their education and rights are protected. Promoting the welfare of our children must always be the driving principle when we consider arrangements, which enable them to participate in these activities.

Recording of children's performances and their adjudications falls under the performers' rights and copyright acts of Canada. These rights and acts which include covering matters as consent, exploitation, intent, harm, creative content, and moral implications, are constantly changing in our laws. It is very easy to find oneself violating a performer's rights or copyright acts should you choose to record them.

In the name of child safety, common decency and in respect for others, the Edmonton Music & Speech Arts Festival Committee asks that you do not record the performances of any child except your own, and that you do not record any performer's adjudication — including your own child's adjudication.

Should you choose to ignore the Committee's request, a common sense approach to keeping you and our children safe might be to:

- Always obtain permission from those directly involved in the creation of a performance video. This includes the performer, the accompanist, and the adjudicator.
- Never place on a public repository (e.g.: Facebook, Twitter, or YouTube) anything that includes a public performance of a child, unless explicit permission has been obtained. It makes no difference how small a piece it is.

The Edmonton Music & Speech Arts Festival has the following Freedom of Information and Privacy Waiver agreed to by all competitors entering the Festival:

By entering into the Edmonton Music & Speech Arts Festival, you give the Festival permission to publish your name in our program, on our website and our other publications. In addition, you give the Festival permission to publish your image and/or record of your performance for rebroadcast or promotional use.

This waiver does not apply to a member of the general public recording someone other than his/her own child/performer.

Please help us keep all our children safe and prospering in the creative arts! Thank you.

Alberta Ukrainian

Commemorative Society Established in 1991, this scholarship acknowledges the significant contributions of Ukrainian settlers in Alberta.

Michael (Mickey) Awid

A prominent local businessman who served as Kiwanis Club President in the 1970s, and whose wife, Evelyn, established this scholarship in his honour.

Heather Bedford-Clooney

Executive Director of the Edmonton Kiwanis Music Festival, Artistic Director of the Columbian Choirs, former Executive Director of the National Music Festival, and Past-President of many music Boards in Canada. She is a member the Edmonton Arts & Culture Hall of Fame.

Paul J. Bourret

A Recognized Executive Director and President of past local and provincial music festivals, he was a renowned educator, choir director, and is a member of the Edmonton Arts & Culture Hall of Fame.

Richard S. Cook

A recognized performer, esteemed educator, past Dean of the Centre for Arts and Communications at MacEwan University, and Interim General Director of Edmonton Opera.

Elaine Dunbar

Elaine Dunbar is a local teacher of piano, voice and theatre, and a member of the RCM College of Examiners. She has fond memories of performing in EKMF; she found it both rewarding and very exciting. Best of luck to everyone; music is a lifelong gift!

Edmonton Kiwanis Oil Capital

The Kiwanis Oil Capital, a branch of the Edmonton Kiwanis Club Organization, is dedicated to changing the world, one child and one community at a time. Their core purpose is to improve lives through leadership and service worldwide.

Edmonton Philharmonic Orchestra

Founded in 1971 by Ranald Shean, the Edmonton Philharmonic Orchestra commissions and performs music written by local composers, and funds scholarships for young players.

Edmonton Recital Society

The Edmonton Recital Society offers innovative and inspiring concerts in an intimate setting. Get up close to world-class artists, many with ties to Edmonton – including many local upand-coming stars, as they perform beloved masterworks and exciting new compositions.

Harry Farmer

A renowned organist, entertainer, music producer, and founder of Edmonton Boys Choir (1958). He established a television program to showcase local talent. He received (posthumously) a City of Edmonton Salute to Excellence Citation Award in Arts & Culture in 2015.

Pamela Farmer

Well-known daughter of Harry and Kathleen Farmer; a generous philanthropist and advocate for Music Education.

Marek Jabłoński

Marek Jabłoński was an internationally distinguished Canadian pianist and teacher who was born in Kraków, Poland, and whose parents immigrated to Edmonton. Jabłoński was an incomparable teacher with a lively intelligence and a matchless ability to communicate. A number of Jabłoński's students now have flourishing careers, among them: Jon Kimura Parker, Kevin Fitzgerald, Bernadene Blaha, and Francine Kay.

Larry Johnson

Larry Johnson is the retired Superintendent of Schools for the St Albert Protestant School Division (1989-1998). Larry and his wife Donna, together with their four daughters, lived in many communities across Alberta, finally ending up in St. Albert where he became the charter president of the St. Albert Rotary Club. A lifetime supporter of music festivals, Larry served as the Chair of the St. Albert Rotary Music Festival (2000-2010) and the President of the Alberta Music Festival Association (2009-2011). The proud grandfather of 12 grandchildren, Larry and Donna now live on an acreage on the Pembina River, and spend many hours each year driving to and from music festivals as volunteers and to hear their grandchildren perform.

Denise Lavigne

Mairead Lavigne, an enthusiastic choir member and pianist, created this scholarship in honour of her daughter, Denise Lavigne.

Madame Jenny Lerouge LeSaunier

A legendary performer and piano teacher who immigrated from Europe to establish a renowned music school in Edmonton. She studied with a student of Robert Schumann. She is a member of the Edmonton Arts & Culture Hall of Fame.

Lucille 'Toots' Longson

Lucille 'Toots' Longson loved Speech Arts & Drama. She said she took every theatre course the U of A had to offer while doing her teacher training there. She attained her ARCT in Speech Arts by studying at night while raising a young family. Toots participated in community theatre productions as a performer, teacher, and director and was an avid theatre goer. Lucille 'Toots' Longson served the Edmonton Kiwanis Music Festival as a long-time volunteer and as its Executive Director. Her husband, Neil Longson, provides this scholarship in her memory.

The McCoy Family Foundation Choral Scholarship

The McCoy family has been part of the business community of Edmonton since the early 1900s when Henry McCoy began "Edmonton Auto Springs". Jim McCoy, a grandson, started the McCoy Family Foundation and is very interested in helping children gain literacy and educational experiences. E.B. "Mac" McKitrick

A recognized leader in the Kiwanis Club who served as International President from 1981-1982.

Ken Myers

Ken Myers, a brilliant saxophonist, performed both locally in Alberta and internationally during his lifetime. Passionate about jazz, Ken played many instruments, but he was also a composer, an arranger, a band leader, and a mentor. Nothing gave him more pleasure than to work with aspiring young saxophonists, encouraging them to continue developing their skills. The Ken Myers Memorial Scholarship will allow his legacy to live on.

National Association of Teachers of Singing (NATS)

An Established group of Teachers of Singing who support singing in the city of Edmonton, and who organize festivals at the national level.

Sandra Leah Page

Ranald Shean

A bequest made in your Will may produce a valuable tax credit on your final tax return. That credit can save your estate a considerable amount of tax if your have RSPs or large holding of capital property that will be deemed to have been disposed of at your death.

In the year of death and the previous year, you may be able to claim a credit for donations up to 100% of your net income. You can name a charity as a beneficiary of an RSP/RIF and qualify the bequest as a charitable donation. In addition, when a charity is named beneficiary on the RSP/RIF, the assets are paid directly to the charity upon the death of the plan holder, and probate taxes can be avoided.

You could name a charity as your life insurance beneficiary while retaining ownership of the policy. The death benefit is paid outside your estate and is not subject to probate taxes. Furthermore, you can receive a donation credit on your final income tax return. The amount of the donation on your final income tax return equals the amount of the death benefit of the policy paid by the insurance company.
